**Notice for Junior National Team Selections:**

**2008 World Junior Championships – Linz, Austria**

Following two days of racing at the National Junior Trials in Welland, ON, Rowing Canada Aviron has reviewed the results and determined that no athletes have met the performance standard for selection consideration for the 2008 World Junior Championships. This decision is based on the published selection criteria in the 2008 RCA National Team Selection document: “Crews selected to represent Canada at the 2008 World Rowing Junior Championships must have the potential to finish in the top six”. RCA utilizes an internal “gold medal standard” to determine percentages required to confirm reasonable probability of performance.

This assessment fee will cover transportation (flights and ground transportation), accommodation, meals, regatta fees, uniforms, and all organized social events.
